

Farm Housing Poses Problem

The loss of farm housing in the Tulelake area to the Federal Bureau of Prisons and the proposed internment camp for subversives may affect the whole Klamath Basin as far as farm labor is concerned this year, according to Migration Barker of the Oregon State Employment Service office here.

Potato acreage is expected to increase this year over last, Barker reported, and even with an increase in bulk machinery available, more help will be needed.

However, he warned that no attempt will be made to bring workers here from other areas unless adequate housing is available.

HOME TIPS

Do not keep cleaning fluids such as gasoline in the house. Use only those safe cleaning fluids that have an Underwriters' Laboratories Inc. label on the can.

Never try to clean an electric toaster by immersing it in water. Brush away any crumbs and wipe the outside with a well-wrung-out soapy cloth. Repeat with a clean, damp cloth, and then rub the surface dry.

RECIPE

FILLET OF SOLE EN PAPILLOTE

Fisherman's Wharf
2 pkgs. Sole
2 cups thick cream sauce
6 finely chopped green onions
1 lb. finely chopped mushrooms
2 kernels finely chopped anchovies
1/4 cup white wine
2 lemons

Roll fillets lengthwise and put toothpick through to hold. Place in pan and cover with water. Add sole, pepper, white wine. Cook ten minutes or until done. Add mushrooms, anchovies, green onions and lemon juice to cream sauce. Thin to desired thickness with stock from fillet of sole and cook five minutes. For you who like something super delicious, home baked pecan, orange glazed or garlic rolls can be made almost as quick as you can say "Jack Robinson." Here's what to do.

PECAN ROLLS

Combine 1/4 cup melted margarine, 2/3 cup brown sugar, firmly packed, and 2/3 cup broken pecan nuts. Spread mixture in bottom of an 8 1/2 x 4 1/2 x 2 1/2 loaf pan. Unwrap 1 package of ready to bake rolls and place on top of sugar mixture. Cover and bake following package directions. Turn rolls out of pan pecan side up and spread sides with any pecan mixture remaining in pan. Serve piping hot.

ORANGE ROLLS

Combine 1/4 cup white corn syrup, 1/4 cup orange juice and 1 tablespoon grated orange rind in small saucepan. Bring slowly to a boil, then simmer about 2 minutes. Unwrap Cloverleaf Rolls and place in baking dish. Pour orange mixture

over rolls and around sides. Bake following package directions. Serve warm with plenty of margarine or butter.

GARLIC ROLL

Peel 1 medium clove garlic and let stand in 1/2 cup margarine or

butter for 45 minutes to 1 hour. Unwrap 1 package of Hard Rolls and slash to top of each cross fashion. Spread garlic butter into slashes and over top of rolls. Place in baking dish and bake following package directions.
