

No More Sulphur - No More 'Lasses - Bread Gives Pep

April showers bring May flowers it's true, but sometimes wet feet and sniffly noses too. Smart homemakers make sure their families eat a hearty, well-balanced breakfast, lunch and dinner each packed with the minerals and vitamins that help to keep those long drawn-out spring colds at a minimum.

Time was when summer's fresh green vegetables had vanished, that the family had to settle down to a more or less routine winter fare of meat-potatoes-cake and pie, and then spring fever, that peppy feeling, appeared, with the ground hog. Out came the sulphur and molasses, grandma's standby for everybody's listlessness.

Caramelized Sugar Flavor Matchless

The matchless flavor of this caramel pudding results from the use of caramelized sugar in its preparation. The amber syrup endows the pudding, too, with eye-appealing color. Milk puddings are simple desserts to prepare and are as popular with grownups as the young-uns. Such desserts afford an easy way to get part of the needed quota of milk into the family diet. Evaporated milk is marvelous for milk puddings, making them richly creamy and smooth. Often, as here, the milk can be used only partially diluted, thereby increasing the flavor and texture goodness and at the same time stepping up the milk content of each serving.

CARAMEL PUDDING
 1/2 cup sugar
 1 cup hot water
 1 egg beaten
 2 tablespoons flour
 1 tall can
 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
 Melt sugar in a heavy pan over low heat, stirring constantly. When syrup is golden brown, add water carefully. Heat until syrup is dissolved. Add flour to beaten egg. Beat until smooth. Add milk. Stir the egg-milk mixture into the caramelized syrup. Cook until mixture thickens, stirring all the while. Add vanilla. Pour into serving dishes. Cool. Makes six 1/2 cup servings.

Brushing a blanket before washing, during drying, and after it has completely dried is extremely important in preventing and minimizing shrinkage as well as reconditioning badly felted blankets.
