NOTICE OF SPECIAL SCHOOL ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the legal voters of School District No. 1 of Klamath County, State of Oregon, that a special budget election will be held within the boundaries of said District at the Fremont School Building, located at 715 High Street, Klamath Falls, Oregon, on the 14th day of May, 1952, from the hour of two o'clock p.m. statutory standard time, to the hour of eight o'clock p.m. statutory standard time, to vote on the question of increasing the amount of the tax levy on said School District No. 1 for the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 1952 and ending on June 30, 1953, on all the taxable property within said District from the amount specified by Article XI, Section 11 of the Oregon Constitution, and of adopting or rejecting the following budget of estimated expenditures for said District for said fiscal year:
