SALEM (AP)—Sagie Nishioka, the American-born Japanese who originally was denied a job with the State Tax Commission, went to work Wednesday for the commission as a junior accountant. He moved here from Seattle, where he had held a job as a clerk for the Army port of embarkation. State Labor Commissioner W. E. Kinsey who administers the state's Fair Employment Practices Law, said the tax commission originally denied Nishioka a job because of his race. The tax commission denied it, although Nishioka placed first in civil service examinations.

Boy Murdered In Delusion

KARACHI, Pakistan (AP)—Police reported Thursday that Mohammed Ahmad, a Karachi physician, slew his nine-year-old son with a butcher knife under the delusion God had given him the same command he gave the prophet Abraham. The 30-year-old widower made this confession: He awoke Wednesday believing he had received God's order to make the supreme sacrifice of his son. Saeed, the boy readily agreed to die in God's name. The doctor bathed his son, dressed him in his best clothes, and made him lie on the floor. Closing his eyes, the father cut off his son's head with four strokes of the knife. The sight of his slaughtered son brought him to his senses, and he tried without success to kill himself. In the Old Testament story, God ordered Abraham to sacrifice Isaac as a test of his love of God, but stayed the knife just as Abraham prepared to plunge it into his son.

LITTERED BY MUMPS—SAN DIEGO, Calif. (AP)—The "doughnut king" of Korea, Pte. Jack Lueken, 21, of San Diego, went unscathed through four trips to the Korean front, but nevertheless arrived home on a stretcher.
