Lodge Going To Portland

SALEM (AP)—U. S. Sen. Henry Cabot Lodge Jr., of Massachusetts, national campaign manager for General Eisenhower, will be in Portland May 5 to talk with Eisenhower's Oregon workers, William L. Phillips, chairman of the Oregon for Eisenhower Committee, announced Wednesday.

Phillips said each local Eisenhower committee in the state is being asked to send five delegates to the conference, which will last most of the day.

Lodge will hold a press conference late that afternoon.

A public rally is scheduled for that evening.

Phillips said other key men in the national Eisenhower organization would campaign in Oregon before the May 16 primary.

Salem Theater Tax Killed

SALEM (AP)—The City of Eugene's 3 per cent tax on theater admissions was thrown out by the Oregon Supreme Court Wednesday on the ground that the city's charter doesn't permit such a tax.

The high court reversed Circuit Judge G. F. Skipworth, Eugene who had upheld the tax.

The suit was brought by the Eugene Theater Co. and Western Amusement Co. against the city.

"The tax imposed by the Eugene ordinance does not possess any of the earmarks of a license or occupation tax," Justice Walter Toozee wrote in the opinion.
