**LIBRARY CLUB AT MERRILL**

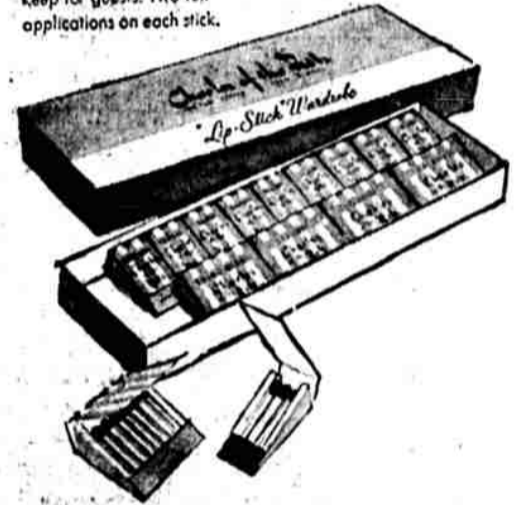

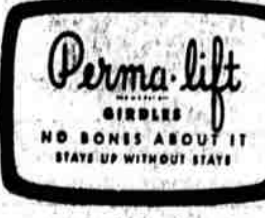
