Truman Asks School Funds

WASHINGTON (AP)—President Truman asked Congress Friday to provide an extra \$11,570,000 for federal payments to schools crowded by pupils from nearby military and defense installations.

The request would cover payments to about 1,800 school districts under the program of emergency aid. A previous appropriation of 40 million dollars was inadequate to make full payments allowed under the law in this fiscal year ending June 30.

The White House said unless the additional \$11,570,000 is made available payments will not go above 75 per cent.

The money would go to the Office of Education for Distribution.

The President also asked an extra million dollars for the fiscal year starting July 1 for additional heating equipment, such as patrol boats for harbors, for the Coast Guard.

RESOLUTION NO. 118

A resolution declaring the intention of the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, to pave and improve the east portion of California Avenue from Union to Delta Street, and declaring and directing certain actions to be taken in connection with said project to be known as improvement unit No. 118.

WHEREAS the City Engineer, pursuant to a resolution of the Common Council heretofore adopted, having filed plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of the east portion of California Avenue from Union to Delta Street, and the Council finding the said plans, specifications and estimates satisfactory for said project, which shall be known as improvement unit No. 118.

Therefore, be it resolved by the common council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, duly assembled in regular session, as follows:

That said plans, specifications and estimates for the improvement of said portion of said street, heretofore filed by the City Engineer, be and the same are hereby approved, and said project shall be known as improvement unit No. 118.

That the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, do hereby declare its intention to improve said portion of said street in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimates as follows:

TYPE "E"—To consist of paving easterly portion of said street five inches depth of asphalt concrete pavement, 18 feet in overall width, including cement curbs and gutters, sidewalks 3 feet wide by four inches in depth, of concrete, to be constructed at the discretion of the City Council.

Sanitary sewer house laterals will be constructed where needed to serve unimproved property to prevent cutting of the pavement at a future date.

TYPE "C"—To consist of paving easterly portion of said street six inches depth of concrete pavement, 18 feet in overall width, including cement curbs and gutters, sidewalks 3 feet wide by four inches in depth, of cement, to be constructed at the discretion of the City Council.

Sanitary sewer house laterals will be constructed where needed to serve unimproved property to prevent cutting of the pavement at a future date.

The estimated cost of all classes of improvements embracing all work and materials for the complete improvement of said project for each type of pavement as follows:

TYPE "E"—Asphalt concrete pavement \$14,232.60

TYPE "C"—Concrete pavement \$17,340.00

Said estimates include engineering supervision, advertising, clerical assistance, attorney's fees and unforeseen contingencies.

Section II

That the property within the boundaries hereinafter described be and the same is hereby declared to be benefited by said improvement, to-wit:
