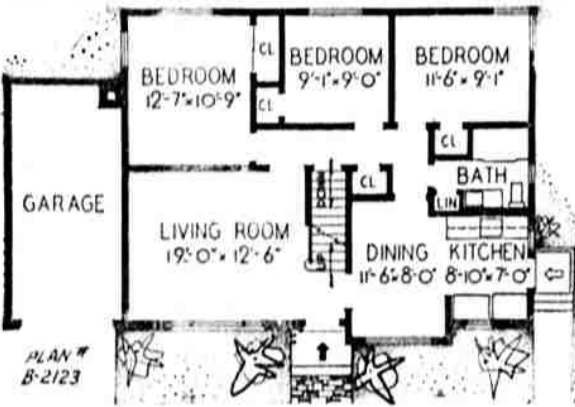


HOMES FOR AMERICANS

Taft Boosted By Wedemeyer

WASHINGTON (AP) — Lt. Gen. Albert C. Wedemeyer Monday assumed the chairmanship of a national Taft-for-President committee and promptly announced that Taft's candidacy is supported by Gen. MacArthur.

that he is supporting Sen. Taft," Wedemeyer said. A spokesman at MacArthur's office in New York said the former Pacific Commander knew of Wedemeyer's announcement but had no immediate comment. The spokesman indicated a statement may be forthcoming later. The Ohio senator, a candidate for the Republican presidential nomination, told the news conference the committee will operate "entirely independent of his campaign organization" and will concentrate on the "public generally." Wedemeyer said Taft's views on foreign policy have been "sound and uniformly have placed America's interest first."

Montreal Has Prison Riot

MONTREAL (AP) — More than 200 police and guards searched Bourdeau Jail Monday for butcher knives, razors and other weapons stolen by 70 rioting prisoners demanding better food and a new jail governor.

Although the riot was quelled Sunday night after five hours in which two prisoners and a guard were injured, a detective said it still was unsafe for guards to walk through the main blocks. Surly prisoners tossed missiles from the upper tiers, and one group was said to be drunk on rubbing alcohol and hair tonic stolen from the infirmary and barber shop. One prisoner stole a bottle of communion wine from the chapel but returned it saying it had a poor taste.

Police said 100 butcher knives and 50 razors were stolen from the kitchen and barber shop at the height of the riot. Dozens of fires were started, and about \$400,000 damage done.

Provincial and city police, hastily summoned to reinforce jail rioters to cells at police headquarters, to quell the uprising, and there was no gunfire. The ob began returning to the main building one or less voluntarily after they were told new food and fresh fruit was being brought them. Their demonstration had erupted in the east hall over a supply of head cheese, corn and potatoes.

The jail governor, Dr. Zenon Le-gage, said an inquiry into the riot would be made as soon as possible. After it might be announced that all was quiet inside.

Thousands of Italian Children in Red Hands

ROME (AP) — Italy now has 250,000 of Stalin's children-card carrying "teen age Communists and pro-Communists."

The Communists are organized in an association called "Italy's Pioneers." Each Pioneer group is the equivalent of a Communist cell.

At the age of 11, when American boys are much more concerned with baseball than politics, Maurizio Clementi, of Rome, told a reporter:

"I can summon the 48 members of my Pioneer group in 25 minutes. In less than an hour I can pass a message to every party member in my area."

The Pioneer groups are most active in Rome, Milan, Modena, Reggio Emilia, Bologna, Genoa and Savona—all important Italian cities where Communism remains strong despite the millions of dollars the United States has poured into Italy to win friends for the west.

The parallel pro-Communist organization is called "The Red Hawks."

Italy has two Socialist parties, one is dominated by the Communists, the other is anti-Communist. The Hawks are divided into 12-member "fights." Each Hawk receives a party card at an impressive ceremony and taken an oath. Instructions include directives for an all-out war against the Catholic Action Youth Groups.

"These Catholic Action Groups are the largest in Italy, with an estimated 1,300,000 members between the ages of four and 14.

The membership is large because children below their 'teens can belong. On the far right is another youth movement, that of the openly Fascist MSI (Italian Social Movement), which boasts 20,000 'teen agers. Authorities agree the Communists and neo-Communists are the best organized among the youth

60-year-old ex-Communist. Then — "acting according to my conscience because he was a traitor to the party," Acerbi shot the old man in the stomach once, through the head twice, tied a boulder to his neck and dumped him into the Po River. He was sentenced to 24 years in prison.

Guido Baldazzini, 19, led a gang of four 'teen agers believed responsible for many of the 200 murders in the Modena area between 1945 and 1947. Trapped in Modena's Communist party headquarters, Baldazzini tried to shoot his way out, wounding two policemen and, ironically,

a Communist leader. Twice — wounded himself, he finally surrendered. "I fulfilled a mission of justice and will continue to do so when released," the young Communist said when brought to trial. He also was sentenced to 24 years in prison.

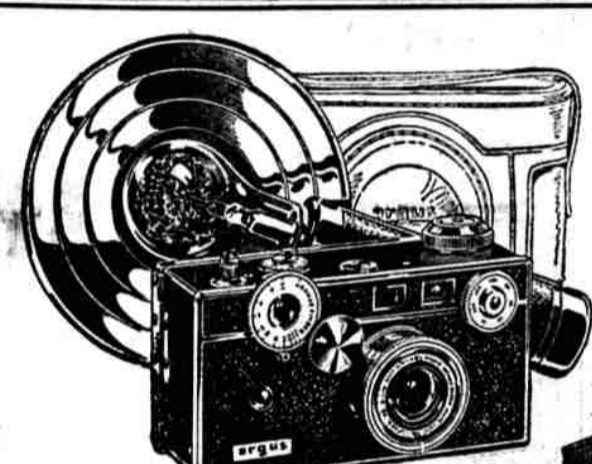
