Dr. Bob Pierce's all-color documentary narrative movie will be shown at the Klamath Falls Army Theatre Tuesday at 7:45 p.m., DST. Titled "The Flame," it covers the Korean War.

Pierce is a missionary stationed who has appeared here before, attracting large crowds. The movie tells a story and at the same time explains the misery and destruction of the Korean "incident."

Solons Agree On GI Boost

WASHINGTON (AP) — A compromise "cost of living" pay increase for the 3 1/2 million persons in the Armed services was agreed upon Thursday by a Senate-House conference committee.

It would give them a 4 per cent increase in base pay and a 14 per cent increase in food and rental allowances.

Dropped from the measure was a Senate proposal for \$45 a month extra combat pay for those fighting in Korea.

Sen. Russell (D-Ga.) said the increase in pay and allowances would cost 484 million dollars a year.

The committee's job was to work out a compromise from differing bills passed by the Senate and House.

Its decisions must now go back to the two branches of Congress for their consideration.
