The agreement is subject to approval by the Wage Stabilization Board. Also to be decided by the WSB is the chief issue in the dispute — a cost-of-living escalator clause.
The union and the employer group, the Retail Lumber Dealers Association, agreed to a union-asked \$1.75 floor on wages, subject to WSB approval.
