Neuner Nixes Union Label

SALEM (AP) — Counties and cities can't require the union label on their printing when purchased from a union shop, Attorney General George Neuner ruled Tuesday.

Neuner also ruled that while there is no law forbidding the use of the union label on county and city supplies, they cannot require contractors to use the label, and they can't condition the letting of contracts upon the use of the union label.

The opinion was for State Rep. Gust Anderson, Portland labor leader.

In another opinion, Neuner declared invalid a regulation adopted by the State Board of Pharmacy.

Logger Killed, Man Held

ROSEBURG (AP) — A Camas Valley logger was found shot to death Monday evening and a 65-year-old man was held for questioning.

The victim was John Henry Jenkins, 37. Boys found his body under a pickup truck in front of the Daniel Webster Smith home at Camas Valley, southwest of here, Smith, 65, was held and District Attorney Robert G. Davis said he and police were questioning him.

Although Jenkins' body was not found until evening, Deputy Coroner Robert Bellows said apparently he had been dead since early afternoon of a shotgun wound.

Mexican Farm Labor Assured

MEXICO CITY (AP) — Labor-hungry U. S. farmers were assured today of a continued supply of migrant Mexicans to help them with their crops.

They had fairly good grounds, also, for expecting more favorable contract conditions with Mexican workers in the future.

Despite discontent with some provisions of the present work contract, the Mexican government has consented to extend it to July 31. For this U. S. farmers are in-

debted in part to the prolonged drought which has left thousands of Mexican farm workers idle.
