A Cold Drink is a Big Help to a Green Thumb

He'll be a better (and more willing) gardener if you are prepared to keep him wet. And that's the truth!

It's the smart homemaker who stocks up on cookies, easy sandwiches, makings, and cold drink ingredients when she expects her "big and handsome" to spend his precious week ends tending a garden.

New on the market and being introduced commercially only in Oregon and Washington cities at the present time, is a fresh frozen apple juice developed by co-operative efforts of growers in the two states. The concentrate makes a wonderfully refreshing drink for any occasion, and especially during or after a hot or trying job.

Preparation of a cold, refreshing drink from this concentrate is the essence of simplicity—needing only a can opener, a pitcher, a

glass and a tap of cold water. Being frozen, the concentrate does its own icing of the drink.

If more nourishment is desired than can be supplied by simple apple juice, try making an egg-nog as follows:

FROZEN APPLE JUICE EGGNOG

1 egg
2-3 cup cream or condensed milk
1 tablespoon honey

Beat egg yolk until thick. Add apple juice and honey. Add cream or condensed milk. Add stiffly beaten egg white. Pour into tall glass and dust with nutmeg. Serve immediately, with ginger snaps or thin peanut butter sandwiches.

GOSH BUT IT'S GOOD

There is something new under the sun—fresh frozen apple juice concentrate. Developed by north-west apple growers through the research department of the Washington State Department of Agriculture, the product is the newest of the popular frozen concentrates.

Boys from 6 to 10 will love it as a refresher after hot jobs like baseball, golf, horseback, or mumble-bee. The men in the family like it because they can fix it themselves. And mothers like it because there are no cores, no peels, no seeds.

The new concentrate is being tested only in states of Washington and Oregon, but early reports indicate enthusiastic consumer reception as fast as the new juice concentrate becomes available.

One tiny can makes 1½ pints of fresh apple juice; and because the concentrate is frozen it provides a ready-made drink in a jiffy.

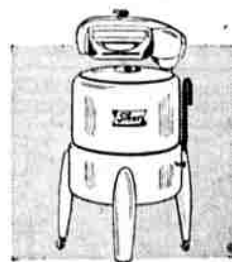

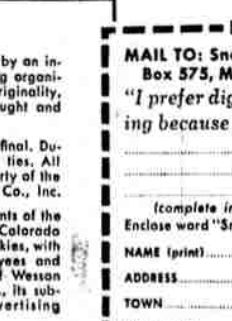
