Friends Give Newsman Lift

PEKIN, Ind. (AP)—A southern Indiana weekly newspaper publisher said Wednesday the response to his appeal to subscribers for loans to help him meet a demand from the federal tax collector "has been quite good."

The publisher, Victor Green, made the appeal in last week's issue of the five weeklies he publishes in Washington county.

"There has been a continuous stream of people coming into the office since last Saturday," said Green. "They have been making loans of from \$1 to \$50. Also letters have come from as far as 100 miles away."

Green's publications last week carried an "S. O. S." banner in big type over the appeal for loans. Green explained today that the U. S. Collector of Internal Revenue at Indianapolis had demanded payment of about \$9,000 in back taxes.
