Bevos Get Loop-Top San Diego

Manager Joe Gordon of Sacramento, one of the all-time greats of the American League, says the Pacific Coast League team capable of putting on a sustained drive late in the season will be the pennant winner this year.

Who might that be?
"It's too early to pick a winner. It's going to be a damn close battle all the way," Gordon holds.

Of his own club, tabbed by some to finish in the cellar, of which it is now co-tenant, the former second baseman for Cleveland and the Yanks says:
"If I had been hitting recently like I did at this time last season we'd either be in first place or a game or two out."

Gordon's average is now .259, and if he's having trouble swatting that ball, he's not the only one. A look at the statistics indicates there must be lead in the balls this year.

Only eight regulars are over the traditional dividing line, the 300 mark. Hank Schenz, the Oakland infielder, is setting the pace at 335, followed by Sacramento's Bob Dillinger, 322, and San Francisco's Joe Green, 314.

This week San Diego, still entrenched in first place by a three-run margin, plays host to Portland Barring the unexpected, the Padres shouldn't have too much trouble maintaining their top spot.

The fireworks should come at Hollywood where the second place Stars entertain third place Oakland.

Sacramento and Seattle, sharing the cellar 12 1/2 games off the pace, meet on the Solons' home ground and Los Angeles, with a revamped lineup, takes on the Seals at San Francisco.

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Adcock, Rosen In Bat Lead

NEW YORK (AP) — Hard-hitting Joe Adcock of the Cincinnati Reds and Al Rosen, sparking of the power-laden Cleveland Indians, have the top slugging averages in the Major League.

Adcock, sidelined by a knee injury last Thursday, has collected 33 hits, good for 66 total bases, in 99 times at bat for a remarkable .667 slugging mark to lead the National League. The Red Sox outfielder has pounded out four doubles, four triples and seven home runs.

Slugging averages released Tuesday by the Associated Press statistical bureau also revealed that Rosen, with five doubles, three triples, ten home runs and 85 total bases, is setting the pace in the American League with a .654 slugging percentage. Rosen has been at bat 130 times and has garnered 44 hits. Averages include games played last Sunday.

Hank Sauer, the big gun in the Chicago Cubs' attack, is giving Adcock a run for National League slugging honors. The husky right-chopper, the league's leading home run hitter with nine, ranks second with .603, a result of 82 total bases in 136 at bats. Hank also has come up with eight two baggers and a pair of triples.

Mills School added the track and field title to its list of athletic accomplishments Friday and Saturday, finishing high in A, B and C divisions for a grand total of 78 points.
