Few Election Costs Filed

Only five persons involved in the May 16 primary election had filed statements of their expenses, as required by state law, with the County Clerk through Monday. All candidates for nomination to local office are required to make an affidavit as to their election spending within 10 days after the election at the County Clerk's office, and candidates for district and state offices make their reports to the Secretary of State in Salem. Those reported here Monday were:

C. F. DeLap, unopposed for Republican nomination for County Clerk, \$45; Keith O'Hair, unopposed Republican for coroner, \$52; Arthur Dickson, winning Republican candidate for assessor, \$107.45; Tom Hela, winning Democratic candidate for assessor, \$113.97; Otis Metsker, losing Democratic candidate for assessor, \$46.70.

Court Upholds Transit Radio

WASHINGTON (AP)—The Supreme court Monday upheld transit radio broadcasts. By a 7-1 vote the high tribunal decided radio broadcasts on buses and street cars do not violate the constitutional rights of passengers. Justice Burton wrote the majority opinion. Justice Douglas wrote a dissenting opinion which asserted: "If liberty is to flourish, government should never be allowed to force people to listen to any radio program. . . . The right of privacy, today violated, is a powerful deterrent to anyone who would control men's minds." Justice Frankfurter said he took no part in the case because "my feelings are so strongly engaged as a victim of the practice in controversy that I had better not par-

ticipate in judicial judgment upon it." That meant the court majority, besides Burton, was composed of Chief Justice Vinson and Justices Clark, Reed, Jackson, Minton. The decision involved broadcasts heard here on street cars and buses of the Capital Transit Company. The dispute attracted wide at-

ention, however, because at least ten other cities have radio broadcasting on public vehicles. The case was taken to the highest tribunal after the U. S. Court of Appeals here declared Capital Transit's broadcasts "deprived objecting passengers of liberty without due process of law" in violation of the Constitution.
