Photographer Sees Decline Of Hollywood's Cheesecake

HOLLYWOOD (NEA) — Behind the Screen: Hollywood cheesecake has gone stale!

That's the word from the dean of movie portrait photographers, Ray Jones of Universal. Internationally studied who declared: "There's no demand for artistry any more in publicity photographs of movie cuties. Glamour art was cheapened during World War II into strip-tease that has become vulgar and distasteful."
