Paper Battles Trust Charge

NEW ORLEANS (AP)—The Times-Picayune Publishing Co. planned Wednesday to appeal to the U. S. Supreme Court from a decision that it had violated the Sherman Anti-Trust Act.

U. S. District Judge Herbert Christenberry, in his decision Tuesday, held that the violation came through the company's requirement that advertisers buy space in both the Morning Times-Picayune and the afternoon New Orleans States.

Application of the forced rates, Judge Christenberry ruled, injured the New Orleans Item, an afternoon newspaper.

The forced combination rates are used by more than 170 morning and afternoon newspapers under joint ownership in the United States.

The government filed the suit in June, 1950, the first in civil anti-trust history where one daily newspaper organization was accused of hurting another competing daily paper.

Farmer Has Potato Hash

HADLEY, Mass. (AP)—This is the story of the harrowing experience of a Hadley farmer, Alden McQueston, who ruefully regarded his ruined potato patch Wednesday. He told his hired man to "go over" a piece of land with a harrow.

The employe did—but over the wrong tract. Result: Four acres of newly planted potatoes ruined. The harrowing was against the rows hopelessly scrambling the seed potatoes.
