### Make It With Buttermilk Low Calories-Eat, Reduce

Do you have a buttermilk fan in your family? Buttermilk is that tangy, refreshing dairy drink, as economical as it is delicious. True buttermilk fans prefer their "straight," creamy cold and gold-flecked with butter.

For those who are on a reducing diet, buttermilk is a modest 85 calories per glass. It contains many of the important vitamins and minerals found in whole milk, giving good food value as well as flavor. Buttermilk is wonderful to cook with, as many homemakers know. It adds a flavor and tenderness to baked foods, pancakes, waffles, biscuits and cookies that can't be matched.

Try serving your family Buttermilk Griddle Cakes for breakfast. They will love 'em, dripping with melted butter and topped with your best strawberry preserves. Another favorite—chocolate cake is made mouth-wateringly tender and delicious with the addition of buttermilk. A quick and easy dessert which will please the family is Buttermilk Pineapple Sherbet. You might vary the fruit to fit the season.

**BUTTERMILK GRIDDLE CAKES**  
(Makes 12 cakes)  
1 cup sifted flour  
1/2 tsp. soda  
1/2 tsp. salt  
1 egg, well-beaten  
1 1/2 cups buttermilk  
1 Tbsp. butter, melted

Sift flour, measure and resift with soda and salt. Beat egg, combine with buttermilk and melted butter. Add to flour gradually stirring only until smooth. Bake on a hot, well-greased griddle until bubbles appear on top. Turn once and bake until lightly browned.

**Buttermilk Chocolate Cake**  
1 1/2 cups sugar  
1/2 cup shortening  
2 squares chocolate  
1 cup hot water  
2 tsp. baking powder  
1/2 tsp. soda  
2 eggs  
2 1/2 cups pastry flour  
1/2 cup buttermilk  
1/4 tsp. salt

### Strawberries are here!



Cream sugar and shortening until blended. Meanwhile, melt chocolate with hot water and stir until smooth. Add to sugar mixture. Beat eggs until light, and add buttermilk. Measure and sift together soda, pastry flour, salt and baking powder. Add to cake mixture alternately with egg and milk mixture. Beat well, pour into greased, floured cake pans; bake at 350 F., for 45 minutes. Frost with your favorite frosting.

**Buttermilk Pineapple Sherbet**  
Mix together: 1 pint buttermilk, 1 cup powdered sugar and 1 small can crushed pineapple. Mix well and freeze. If made in an automatic refrigerator, stir frequently while freezing to prevent pineapple from settling.
