Britain Holds Trade Position

LONDON (AP) — The drain of the sterling area's gold-dollar reserves has been less than 25 million dollars since March 1, Chancellor of the Exchequer R. A. Butler told a crowded House of Commons Thursday.

He emphasized that Britain is holding its position, but must do better.

Butler's statement came on the heels of a warning by Prime Minister Churchill Wednesday that Britons stood over a "treacherous trapdoor" that might drop them to economic disaster. Churchill called on Britons to boost trade throughout the Commonwealth to avoid economic disaster.
