

# Championship Fight Here Tonight

## Title May Go With KO Blow

The big blue chips will be piled high in the Armory ring here tonight and both the champion and the challenger are deadly determined to win.

Earl Turner, the Northwest middleweight champ, has a lot to lose. And he doesn't intend losing.

"I'm going to win this one. I've got to win it," says the California Negro.

Dick Wolfe, the Northwest welterweight title holder, needs a win over a name fighter like Turner. Wolfe is anxious for a go at bigger bouts. If he can whip Turner and gain the middleweight crown, it will be a big jump up the fistie ladder.

**READY**

Both Turner and Wolfe appear in the proverbial pink for tonight's fight. At the weigh-in today, both appeared completely confident.

When two hard-hitters like Turner and Wolfe enter a ring feeling that way, chances are the fight will end with one of them on the seat of his pants while the third man in the ring counts slowly to ten.

The KO punch could come from either man. Turner has full respect for Wolfe's wicked left hook. "He nailed me with it once good," says Turner, "and it really hurt."

## Snead's Match Top Tilt

**LOUISVILLE** — The golf world, in a nostalgic mood, relived one of the most dramatic of championship playoffs as Sam Snead, defending champion in the PGA championship, encountered Lew Worsham in a first round "sudden death" match.

Their meeting is the one stand-out of the 32 first-round 18-hole matches and the 16 second-round tussles that follow immediately.

It takes the edge off the others: off Thursday's par-burning activities over the sun-baked 6,620-yard Big Spring course and off Dutch Harrison's stellar shooting that won the medal.

**PRIZE SCORE**

Harrison, scrambling and suffering at times, shot rounds of 67-69—136 to capture the \$250 medalist's prize after Snead and a half-dozen red hot bidders failed.

Worsham, who seized the front nine with a record six-under-par 30, former Open champion Lloyd Mangrum and Cary Middlecott were among those who bid for records on the first nine and failed on the second. Mangrum had a 139.

In the end it was broad-shouldered Harry Todd of Dallas who came in with a 66, best score of the day, to take second place at 137.

Roberto DeVicenzo, of Argentina, Henry Williams Jr., of Kutztown, Pa., runner-up in the 1950 GA championship, and Fred Grobauer of Port Washington, N.Y., all had 138.

**N. W. HOPE**

In Friday's round, Mangrum was paired against Frank Newell Jr., Tacoma, one of the two Pacific Northwest entries. Newell posted a 145 Thursday.

Ray Honsberger of Clarkston, Wash., who had a 140 Thursday, met Tom Blaskovich of Connellsville, Pa., who carded a 146.

Friday's two 18-hole rounds reduce the field to 16 players, who will continue over the 36-hole route until the final next Tuesday.
