

Allies To Go Back to Talks

MUNSAN, Korea (AP) — Allied negotiators return to the Korean armistice conference Saturday to learn if their second walkout has convinced the Communists to change their minds.

The meetings at Panmunjon have been stalled almost two months by Communist refusal to accept the Allied declaration that 100,000 Red war prisoners do not want to go back to Communism. Only about 70,000 prisoners have indicated a willingness to return to Red territory.
