PORTLAND — The Oregon Presbyterian Synod was told Wednesday that at least five new churches for the state are planned from money to be raised in the Presbyterian building fund campaign.

The Rev. Paul Wright, chairman of the Oregon campaign, said \$91,051 of the state's \$199,658 quota had been pledged. The value of the churches will exceed the state's contribution, he said.

The churches are planned for North Eugene, Springfield, Medford, Brookings and three suburban Portland areas.
