State Gets Military Fund

WASHINGTON (AP) — The \$2,380,587,800 military expenditures bill passed by the Senate Thursday night included \$30,872,000 for Army, Navy and Air Force projects in Washington and Oregon.

The total was \$368,730,200 less than voted by the House. Differences between the house and Senate versions will be worked out by a conference committee.

An Air Force appropriation of \$973,000 for the Portland International Airport at Portland, Ore., was one of the two Northwest projects not reduced by the Senate.

The other was \$744,900 for Geiger Field at Spokane.

These were the changes made by the Senate (House figures first, Senate second):

Army: Fort Lewis, Tacoma — \$942,000 and \$272,000.

Navy: Naval Communication Station, Snohomish County, \$1,520,000 and \$1,450,000.

Air Force: Fairchild AFB, Spokane, \$9,471,000 and \$9,421,000.

Geiger Field, Spokane, \$744,000 and \$744,000.

Larson AFB, Moses Lake, \$12,818,100 and \$10,866,000.

McChord AFB, Tacoma, \$6,730,000 and \$5,805,000.

Paine Field, Everett, \$1,299,000 and \$1,251,000.

POST MASTERS WASHINGTON (AP) — President Truman has nominated as postmasters in Oregon, Samuel R. Veatch, Cottage Grove, and Franz L. Kraenburg, Prairie City. They go now to the Senate.

Big Planes Makes Runs

TOKYO (AP) — Giant C-124 Globemaster transports, each capable of carrying more than 200 passengers or 250 tons of cargo, are making regular flights between Japan and Korea, Far East Air Forces announced Friday.

The first scheduled Globemaster flight was Thursday, with Brig. Gen. Chester E. McGarry of Portland, Ore., at the controls. McGarry is commander of the 315th Air Division (combat cargo) which handles the Korean airlift.

On the inaugural flight the Globemaster carried five jet engines weighing 23,000 pounds, 30 passengers and its regular crew.

Traffic Cop Suffers Bite

FORT WORTH, Tex. (AP) — Every one's nerves get frayed in a traffic jam—even a dog's.

City policeman E. R. Forister was breaking up a traffic snarl. Several times he whistled and urged a woman motorist to drive on.

Finally, as she drove past him her fox terrier leaped from a window and nipped Forister's shoulder.

The officer commandeered a car and stopped the woman after a four-block chase.

First the woman took the officer to her husband's place of business, where Forister was paid for his torn shirt, then she took him to a hospital for treatment of a shoulder gash.

But the lady driver was cheerful about the entire situation. She said she was glad the dog had been vaccinated against rabies.

Group Asks To Testify

PORTLAND (AP) — The Northwest Public Power Association Thursday asked the Federal Power Commission for permission to testify July 14 at the FPC's hearing at Baker on Oxbow Dam.

The association, a group of Pacific Northwest public and cooperative power suppliers, opposes the Idaho Power Company's plan to build the dam. Gus Norwood, executive secretary of the organization, said the proposed dam might increase wholesale power rates.

The group favors instead federal construction of Hells Canyon Dam.

RUBBER FOR REDS

COLOMBO, Ceylon (AP) — The Polish freighter Jednosoc Robotnicza left Thursday with 4,400 tons of rubber for Communist China.

With this shipment the total sent to the Chinese mainland from Ceylon since last October is 17,500 tons.
