Korean War Action Flares

SEOUL, Korea (AP) — United Nations troops Wednesday drove on North Korean Communists entrenched on a ridge at the Eastern end of the Korean battle line but lost a key hill to counter-attacking Chinese in the center.

The U. S. Eighth Army reported Allied infantrymen in the east killed 42 Reds and wounded 65 others in an action that was still under way at 3 p. m.

Steep slopes slowed the U. N. advance but troops moving in from two directions were reported only 50 yards apart.

Between 350 and 400 Chinese in hand to hand fighting recaptured a hill U. N. troops had wrested from them 24 hours earlier.

The hill, in the Pukhan River Valley, was captured by U. N. troops 24 hours before.

Communist casualties in the counterattack were not estimated, but in fighting for the hill Tuesday 60 Chinese were killed.

U. S. Thunderjets again bombed the big No. 2 power plant at Changlin Reservoir Tuesday after reconnaissance showed the Reds were trying to get the generators back in operation.

The plant was one of 13 North Korean hydroelectric stations knocked out in heavy raids two weeks ago.

Ike Appeals For Unity

CHICAGO (AP) — Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower appealed Tuesday for Republican harmony and for "kicking the Democrats so far November 4 that it'll take them about 20 years to get back."

Eisenhower, a top contender for the GOP presidential nomination, came up with the unity appeal and the slug-the-Democrats remarks at a breakfast with the 26-vote Missouri delegation to the party's national convention.

He met with the group after victory of his forces over those of Sen. Robert A. Taft at the opening session of the convention.

The Eisenhower camp, however, was tempering elation with caution in continuing to predict an early ballot nomination of the general.

At the meeting with the Missouri delegation, which backed him 22 to 4 over Taft in the dispute over seating delegates, Eisenhower told the group the Republicans must close ranks after the convention and concentrate on defeating the Democrats in November.

"There is only one thing to do when you are in an inter-family fight and that is to close ranks," he declared.

Then he added the remark about "kicking the Democrats" back.

The general also declared that "as long as we are in this thing, let's stick it on together and throw the stove lid at anything that gets in our way."

Lane County To Have Maps

EUGENE (AP) — The Lane County Court Tuesday awarded a \$5,996 contract to Pacific Aerial Surveys of Seattle to make aerial photographs of 731,520 acres of Lane County this summer.

The project will be part of a three-year program aimed to supply the county with up-to-date maps which will be used to equalize taxes.

County Judge Day T. Bayly said a total of 1,617,500 acres of the county eventually will be photographed and mapped to give the county assessor a picture of volume and types of timber.

'Shoemakers' Irk Russian

MOSCOW (AP) — A Soviet satirist thundered Tuesday that anybody who wears the shoes made by the Penza region's Kuznetzk shoe factory will have to walk tip-toe. All the shoes have nails sticking up through the heels.

Satirist G. Rykin, writing in the government newspaper Izvestia, snorted that the heads of the Kuznetzk factory are nothing but "shoemakers."

In Russia, "shoemaker" is practically a bad word. It is used as an epithet to describe anyone who is totally incompetent.

The Kuznetzk factory, said Rykin, has spoiled its goods for two years.

In 1951, he added, 18,000 pairs of women's and men's shoes had to be junked, and "special attention was devoted to spoiling women's summer sandals."

The trouble, said Rykin, is this: "During the first three weeks of each month the heads of the Kuznetzk factory 'catch flies and count crows' and then during the last week declare 'storms' ('to all out') to fulfill the output quota set by the plan, forgetting totally about quality."

Women Admitted To Cooks Group

BOLOGNA, Italy (AP) — This city's association of cooks finally admitted that women, at least potentially, can fry an egg.

For the first time since the association was founded 50 years ago, 16 women cooks were awarded association diplomas.

Said Association President Carlo Bolognini: "Members have generously decided to make peace with the women cooks in recognition of their potential culinary abilities."

WASHINGTON (AP) — The World Bank Tuesday announced a 20-year, 50 million dollar loan to Australia to finance purchases of equipment needed to develop that country's mining, transportation, power and farm industries.

Better Fescue Need Stressed

Acreage, almost tripled in the nation during the past three years, is beginning to put emphasis on quality for the state's certified tall fescue growers, says H. E. Fennell, Oregon State college extension certification specialist.

In 1949, 9,795 acres of alta fescue and 12,931 acres of Kentucky 31 were certified in the United States. By 1951, acreage of certified alta had hit 19,917 and Kentucky 31 acreage had almost reached 44,000 acres. Both are tall fescue strains and compete in most markets.

OREGON LEADS

Fennell says 12 states report certifying alta fescue last year. Oregon led with 12,281 acres followed by Idaho with 8,845 acres. Production in the 12 states totalled 4,237,000 pounds of certified seed.

Fifteen states, mostly southern, report certifying Kentucky 31 last year with Kentucky leading the list with 30,901 acres or more than 70 percent of the total acreage. The 15 states certified almost 7,000,000 pounds of seed.

The figures and trends, says Fennell, mean just one thing for Oregon producers: to survive, farmers must produce the best quality seed in the nation or the market will likely slowly fade away under pressure of outside competition.

To compete, the specialist adds, Oregon growers must produce alta fescue which is ryegrass free and contains no cheat, chess and sorrel. These contaminants are affecting local certified alta fescue seed adversely.

LADINO COVER

Another certified crop which is on the climb is ladino clover. Last year in this country, 56,615 acres were certified. This compares with a 1950 total of 42,855 acres.

Oregon was the ranking state with 25,360 acres followed closely by California with 23,755 acres. Idaho ranked third with 5,002 acres. Oregon and California produced 7,939,750 pounds of the total 8,439,267 pound total certified crop.

Altogether, 11 states produced certified ladino clover in 1951.

Kaiser Now Biggest

OAKLAND, Calif. (AP) — Kaiser Aluminum & Chemical Co. announced that its primary aluminum reduction plant near Spokane, Wash., became the largest in the country Wednesday when the plant's eighth potline was placed in operation.

The new potline added about 44,000,000 pounds of primary aluminum to the Mead plant's production capacity, boosting its total capacity to 350,000,000 pounds a year.

The expansion is part of the corporation's general program to more than double its aluminum capacity by mid-1953 to about 816,000,000 pounds annually.

Sulphur Dioxide Aids Silage

Use of sulfur dioxide gas in silage making is described in a new folder released by the Oregon State college extension service.

It is extension circular 531, entitled "Making Good Silage." Similar to other circulars distributed by OSCE, copies are available free at either county extension offices or by writing direct to the college.

The circular states that sulfur dioxide must be applied at the rate of five pounds per ton of green material. It is suggested that a platform scale be used to measure the amount applied.
