A Frank 'n Bean Casserole attracts appetites on the double when the franks are fixed with a cheese filling. First pour 2 cans (1-pound 7-ounce size) of pork and beans into an oblong baking dish; heat in moderate oven while fixing franks. Take beans out of oven and arrange franks over top; place under broiler until cheese is melted. Makes 6 servings.
