Idaho "Ghost Town" Site of Convention

By BOB LEERIGHT SILVER CITY, Idaho (P) — Hotel reservations won't bother the 1,300 Idaho and Eastern Oregon stockmen overflowing this historic "ghost city" for the 74th annual convention of the Owyhee Cattlemen's Association July 26-27.

There aren't any hotels in Silver City — just plenty of wide open spaces for the cattlemen to park their bedrolls and a whirl of sagebrush to make sleeping easier. Once a bustling mining camp of 20,000 people, Silver City has dwindled to a few dilapidated buildings.

But each year cattlemen from throughout the area buck the narrow, dusty mountain road into the isolated convention site by horseback, Jeep and Cadillac to relive the glories of Silver City.

A choice beef will be "cut out" of one of the many cattle herds in Owyhee and Eastern Oregon stockmen who had flocked into the rich gold-producing area.

Gold was first discovered in the southwest corner of Idaho in 1863 when a party of 29 prospectors searching for "lost diggings" in

TACOMA (P) — One of the first orders of business when the U.S. House of Representatives reconvenes should be a scientific study of rain-making, Rep. Henry M. Jackson (D-Wash.) said here Tuesday.

Conflicting reports on the value to the Pacific Northwest of the proposed Oxbow Dam on the Snake River were presented Monday at a Federal Power Commission hearing.

The Idaho Power Company wants to build the 140,000 kilowatt dam as a quick source of power. Arthur Imman, vice president of the firm, said the dam could be built in 18 to 24 months. It would be one of a series of five dams which the company could complete in 10 years at a cost of 140 million dollars, he said.

Howard Stinson, Boise, attorney for the Bureau of Reclamation, criticized the plan. He said he proposed Hells Canyon Dam, which the government wants to build and operate in the same area, would generate 130,000 kilowatts of power compared with the 390,000 to 530,000 from Idaho Power's proposed five low dams.

The hearing continued Wednesday.
