

Flowers from OLD NYLONS

Making gay, colorful flowers and corsages from re-dyed nylon stockings is latest hobby sweeping nation.

Cost of making the long-lasting flowers is trifling.

First use color remover on nylon. Then tintex hose in floral color desired. Next, make petals by stretching square of nylon over a strand of copper screen-wire. Five or more petals are assembled in form flower. With waxed crochet cotton for center, petals are tied at base with wire and stem covered with green floral tape.

RECIPE

For a dessert that will please for party or family meal try serving apricot fluff pie. Here is a light fluffy pie which is garnished with fresh apricot halves and whipped cream. It is a treat that can be served with confidence.

APRICOT FLUFF PIE

1 tablespoon gelatin
1 cup cold water
2 cups coarsely cut apricots
6 apricot halves
1/2 cup water
2 eggs separated
1 cup sugar
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 tablespoon lemon juice
2 tablespoons sugar
1/2 cup whipping cream
1 baked 9-inch pie shell.

Soften gelatin in cold water.

FRESH APRICOT PIE

3 cups halved, fresh apricots
1/2 cup water
1 cup sugar
3 tablespoons flour
1 tablespoon lemon juice
1 tablespoon butter
1 recipe pastry for 9-inch double crust pie.

Line a pie plate with pastry. Arrange fresh ripe apricots in pastry shell. Combine flour and sugar. Sprinkle over fruit. Sprinkle with lemon juice. Dot with butter. Cover with top crust, vent to allow steam to escape. Bake at 425 F. for 35 to 40 minutes.

Helps greatly when washing clothes, less soaking, less rubbing.

Cool Summer Salads Tasty Serve Often

When the weather turns warm, a cool salad looks and tastes better than ever. Appetites are fussy on hot days, and to be tempting, food must look cool, refreshing and attractive—and taste that way.

Molded salads, crisp cole slaw and cool mixed salad bowls make excellent summer menu entries. They may be served as the main dish if substantially fortified with a hearty protein food such as meat, cheese, eggs or fish. Then simply add hot soup, rolls or crusty French bread and a favorite fruit dessert.

Dairy foods such as cheese, cottage cheese, milk and whipping cream help make summer salads tasty and appetizing. Remember dairy foods when you are preparing meals in any season—they are ready to use, economical to serve and good to eat! Try these delicious summer salads and see!

LINE SEAFOOD SALAD (Serves 8)

2 packages lime-flavored gelatin
3 cups hot water
1 1/2 lbs. drained cottage cheese
1 Tbsp. chopped onion
1 Tbsp. vinegar or lemon juice
1/2 cup horse-radish
2 Tbsp. mayonnaise
Watercress or greens
1 to 2 cups cooked shrimp

Dissolve gelatin in hot water. Chill until partially set. Beat until light. Stir in remaining ingredients, except watercress and shrimp. Pour into a 9-inch ring mold which has been rinsed in cold water. Chill until set. Unmold. Fill center with watercress and shrimp, cooked and chilled. Serve with mayonnaise.

FROZEN CHICKEN SALAD (Serves 4)

1/2 cup cold diced chicken
1 cup diced pineapple
3 Tbsp. chopped nuts
1-3 cup heavy cream, whipped
1-3 cup mayonnaise

Mix chicken, pineapple and nuts. Add whipped cream. Mix in mayonnaise. Freeze for 3 hours. Serve on lettuce and garnish with mayonnaise.

CALIFORNIA SALAD BOWL (Serves 6)

2 cups 1/2-inch bread cubes
1 cup salad oil
2 cloves garlic
2 heads green lettuce
1 tsp. dry mustard
1/4 tsp. black pepper
1/2 tsp. salt
1 cup crumbled blue cheese
1-3 cup lemon juice
1-3 cup salad oil

2 eggs

Fry breadcubes in the 1/2 cup salad oil which has had the garlic crushed in it. When cubes are golden brown, remove from pan and cool. Break lettuce into small pieces in salad bowl. Sprinkle with mustard, salt, pepper and cheese. Combine lemon juice with 1/3 cup salad oil and pour over greens. Break eggs which have been simmered gently for only 3 minutes, over apricots. Toss gently to mix cubes and toss lightly again. Serve immediately.

HONEY ORANGE SAUCE

Blend honey into one cup orange juice to sweeten to taste. Add two tablespoons grated orange peel. Blend well. This is an excellent sauce to serve on waffles, hot cakes and French toast as well as on Shortcake.
