Cottonwood Road Work Progresses

LAKEVIEW — Repair and improvement work at Camp Cottonwood Meadows progressed this week in preparation for the opening of the annual 4-H summer camp Sunday, July 27. It was announced by Lee Hanson, Lake County 4-H agent. The summer camp is sponsored by the Lake County 4-H Leaders Association.

A use permit to take a number of trees blown down during the winter storms was given to Cottonwood Camp Inc., by the Fremont National Forest for use in repairing and improving the site. Frank and Ray Padgett and Ray Kerr saved these into 15 foot lengths and hauled them to the Kos and Glen Ray Sawmill west of Lakeview where the Rays volunteered to saw them into lumber for the camp. About 6000 feet of this lumber is being dried by the American Forest Products Corporation for use as flooring and sheathing.

The lumber will be used to build a 22 by 40 foot dining hall adjacent to the south end of the kitchen which was given to the camp by the Elks Lodge last year. The kitchen building suffered considerable damage from heavy snow last winter, which caved in the roof and this is to be repaired by camp time.

On Saturday and Sunday, July 12 and 13, a group of volunteers under the direction of Lester Vandergaw, laid the foundation for the new building. A large group of volunteers, from among 4-H leaders and parents and Girl Scout parents and friends, are asked to be at the camp early Sunday, July 20, to put the new roof on the kitchen, and complete construction of the dining hall.

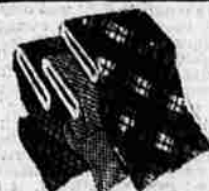

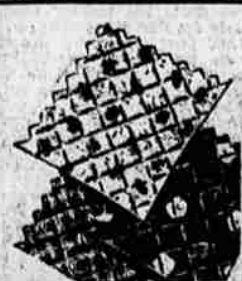
