

# Court Denies Alger Hiss New Trial

NEW YORK (AP) — Alger Hiss appeal for a third trial — based largely on his contention that he was a victim of forgery by typewriter — was denied Tuesday in Federal District Court.

Of the convicted perjurer's motion, Federal Judge Henry W. Goddard wrote in his opinion:

"There is no newly discovered evidence which would justify the conclusion that, if it were presented to a jury, it would probably result in a verdict of acquittal."

Hiss, 47, one-time high State Department official, was convicted at his second trial in January, 1950, an initial trial the previous year ended with the jury deadlocked. He now is serving a five-year term

at Lewisburg, Pa., federal prison. The indictment against Hiss said he lied to a federal grand jury when he testified he never gave State Department secrets to Whitaker Chambers, a former Communist spy ring courier, before World War II.

At his sentencing two and a half years ago, Hiss told Goddard that he was "confident that in the future all the facts will be brought out to show how Whitaker Chambers was able to carry out forgery by typewriter."

Last January, months after Hiss had gone to prison and the U. S. Supreme Court had declined to review the case, Hiss attorneys made the bid for the new trial on

grounds of the allegedly faked typewriter and other "new evidence."

Goddard said Tuesday that the Hiss attorneys had submitted no proof to support the "defendant's supposition . . . that Chambers constructed the alleged duplicate typewriter from the typewritten characters in the Hiss letters, or that it was done for him by some Communist friends."

The typewriter was entered as evidence at the two trials. Chambers produced documents and testified they were copies of government papers made for the Soviet spy ring on the typewriter by Hiss and his wife.

Chester T. Lane, Hiss' attorney, said he would decide whether to appeal Goddard's decision after reading the opinion.

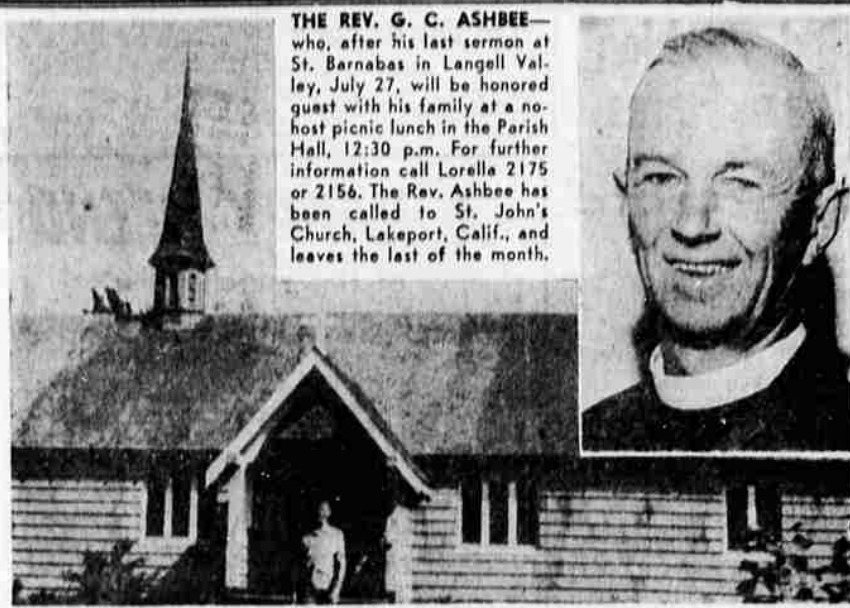

## Hospitals Get Money

PORTLAND (AP) — The State Board of Health Wednesday announced that more than \$400,000 had been granted to Oregon hospitals under the federal Hill-Burton Act.

Most of the federal assistance money — \$327,821 — went to the Salem General Hospital for a 60-bed addition. Total cost, with the hospital putting up the balance, will be \$923,464.

The new unit will be used for pediatrics and obstetrics, Dr. Har-

old M. Erickson, state health officer, said.

A grant of \$89,466 was made to the Salem Memorial Hospital for a 41-bed addition. Total estimated cost of the addition, which will be for general use, is \$268,400.

The Good Samaritan Hospital,

Corvallis, was granted \$2,761 to complete the structure, started last year.

The board administers the Hill-Burton Act in Oregon. Final approval for grants is required from the U. S. Public Health Service.

## Fire Burns Barn, Stock

CORVALLIS (AP) — An auction barn, 33 head of cattle and a valuable Quarterhorse stallion were destroyed by fire here Tuesday midnight.

Owner Earl Gillaspie estimated the loss at \$75,000 to \$100,000. He said he had \$28,000 insurance.

The fire started in the fumigation room where cyanide gas was stored. The gas exploded, shooting flames through the barn.

Sixteen holstein calves, part of 200 recently brought here by air from Wisconsin by Gillaspie, were saved. The remainder had been sold earlier.
