Recipe

WONDERFUL

Sandwiches made with thin slices of whole wheat bread, cream cheese and chopped walnuts are hard to beat when it comes to serving something tasty with fruit salads. Moisten the cheese with enough orange juice to give spreading consistency and stir in a generous amount of finely chopped walnuts.

SAVE

peach halves. Combine with 6 cut-up marshmallows, 2 tablespoons chopped almonds, one cup sweetened whipped cream and a cup of cubed stale cake. Chill several hours.

HEARTY

Prepare this hearty salad in the cool of the morning and slip it into the refrigerator until serving time. Drain syrup from canned cling peach slices, add water to make 2 cups and heat to boiling.

Dissolve a package of lemon-flavored gelatin in the hot liquid and chill until slightly thickened. Fold in 1 cup each canned cling peach slices and cottage cheese and 1/2 cup mayonnaise. Pour into individual molds and chill until firm.

TASTY

Add these good little bites to your appetizer tray. Dip large cubes of Calavo in lemon juice and roll in crushed potato chips. Eat them as finger food or serve with picks. Easy and delicious!
