Polio Spreads In East Oregon

PENDLETON (AP) — A polio outbreak has spread to Grant County south of here with the illness at Canyon City of a 3-year-old boy.

The boy the first to be stricken in the county this year was taken to a Walla Walla Wash. hospital for treatment.

Umatilla County has had 20 cases this year, including five reported since July 17. Dr. E. E. Berg county health officer said four of the 20 victims have been released from hospitals.

DuPont Head Dies At 71

NEW LONDON, Conn. (AP) — Lamont DuPont, 71, one of three brothers who led the development of the modern E. I. DuPont de Nemours & Co., Inc., from a small black powder factory 150 years ago to one of the great chemical companies of the world, died at a hospital here Thursday.

DuPont had been ill for several weeks and had been taken to the hospital recently from his summer home on Fischer's Island, N.Y.

The youngest of three brothers who built up the mighty industrial domain, was president of the company for 14 years.

He headed it from 1926 to 1940, succeeding his brothers, Pierre and Irenee in that position.

From 1940 to 1948 he was chairman of the board. It was during that period that DuPont company was called upon to use its scientific skills in helping to make A-bombs and Lamont shared in many of the important decisions.

Pope Writes To Russians

VATICAN CITY (AP) — Pope Pius, in his first apostolic letter to all the peoples of Russia, has appealed to them to "return to truth and to the right path."

"Undoubtedly," the Pontiff wrote, "we have condemned and rejected, as the duty of our office demands, the errors which the promoters of atheistic Communism teach and try to propagate to the greatest detriment and misfortune of the citizens."

But, he added, "we do not turn away" the persons who are in error.

"We desire that they should return to the truth and the right path," he said.

Aircraft Board Recommends Production of Stratoforts

WASHINGTON (AP) — W. L. Campbell, acting chairman of the Aircraft Production Board, recommended Wednesday that mass production of Boeing's eight-engine Stratofortress be boosted at the expense of other long-range bomber programs.

Campbell's recommendation, if adopted, would also continue the current heavy production of the six-jet Boeing B-47B and C models, but would wipe out the Martin B-57A Canberra in favor of the Douglas B-66, an Air Force version of the Navy's AJD attack bomber.

Also wiped out by the recommendation would be production lines for such well-known airplanes as the Northrop F-89, Republic F-84G, Douglas F-3D, Lockheed F-94C and Grumman F-9F and F-10F.

Such aircraft would give way to increased production of the Republic F-84F, North American F-86F and F-86D, the McDonnell F-3H and F-3H, and the Douglas F-4D-1 Skyray.

The recommendation was made to the board by Campbell, on the basis of a staff field survey lasting several weeks.
