Woman Hurt In Jail Fight

An Indian woman, Laverne Walker McKennie, is in Klamath Valley Hospital for treatment of injuries received in a jailhouse brawl at Bly yesterday.

Deputy Sheriff Willis Pankey said Mrs. McKennie, who has been living in Portland, was tossed in jail yesterday for being drunk, and some time later another Indian woman, Giffie Kirk, was put in the cell with her.

Several other persons also were jailed at Bly during the day, Pankey said, and he was bringing in another prisoner when he saw the McKennie woman on the floor, with Miss Kirk working her over.

Mrs. McKennie was given emergency treatment at Bly, then brought to the hospital by two Indian Service officers.

She has facial, head and pelvic injuries.

Two Hurt In Portland Fire

PORTLAND (AP) — Two men were burned, one seriously, in a fire which ripped through a Northwest Portland roofing plant Wednesday.

Weldon C. Leisy, 46, was hospitalized with burns from the blaze which destroyed the Gilsonite Roof Products Co. Ronald Warner, 52, another employee, suffered minor burns and was released from the hospital after treatment.

The fire destroyed a nearby unoccupied house when tar products caught fire, spreading the blaze. Company officials said they had \$18,000 insurance on the building. Damage was estimated by firemen at \$60,000.
