Court Rules On Slaying

OLYMPIA (AP)—The state supreme court ruled Thursday that a man who murdered his father may inherit the father's estate. A unanimous opinion, which members of the high court said "shocks our conscience," stated: "We believe that the existing applicable statutes can only be construed to permit appellant to inherit his father's estate. A result more consistent with acceptable standards of common decency must await action by the state legislature."

2nd Division In Action

SEOUL, KOREA, Friday (AP)—The Army announced today the U.S. Second Division is the allied outfit fighting Chinese troops for possession of "Old Baldy," a prize hill on the western front and scene of a week-long battle. The Second Division is one of the famed outfits of the 25-month-old Korean War. The Chinese Red radio has reported that the U.S. Second Division had replaced the 45th Division which took the hill from the Chinese last month. Chinese troops now hold the crest of the ridge with second division infantrymen on the southern slope. The U.S. First Marine Division has been fighting in the Western sector near the Panmunjom conference site since last March. This is north of the battle for "Old Baldy."
