Ambassador O'Dwyer Denies Mexican Citizenship Tales

MEXICO CITY (AP)—Ambassador William O'Dwyer furiously denied reports Tuesday he was considering becoming a Mexican citizen. The ambassador's violent reaction was provoked by a news story (not by the Associated Press) which speculated on the possibility of O'Dwyer retiring from public life after the November elections in the U. S. and becoming a citizen of Mexico. O'Dwyer, former New York City mayor, has been very popular in this country. O'Dwyer learned by telephone Tuesday morning of publication of the story and immediately summoned U. S. correspondents to the embassy residence. One of the correspondents present was Robert Prescott, United Press bureau chief, author of the story. O'Dwyer greeted the newsmen

second, because he did not have a degree from a Mexican law school. Midway through the news conference, he ordered Prescott to leave the embassy. Prescott left after stating that he had his original notes on the telephone conversation to bear out his story.

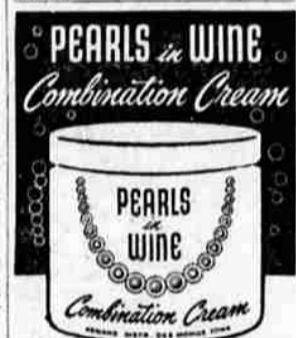

NPA Orders Tin Output

WASHINGTON (AP)—The National Production Authority Tuesday placed tinplate mills and can manufacturers under strict orders to speed their output to the rescue of the fruit and vegetable crops. The agency also disclosed that, shortly before the steel strike ended, it had studied the possibility of an Air Force airlift to get tinplate to the Pacific Coast. The airlift was abandoned in favor of special fast freight trains, which have been moving to West Coast canning centers since Sunday, and rapid highway shipment arranged by the Defense Transport Administration. NPA telegraphed these instructions to 93 can companies, 27 producers of lids and closures, and the newly opened tinplate mills: 1. They must certify, in ordering tinplate from reopened mills, that the cans made from the metal will be used only to pack perishable foods. 2. Tinplate mills must offer tinplate, of types not ordinarily used for food canning but suitable for that purpose, to canmakers who

certify they can not meet packers' requirements for crops being harvested immediately. 3. Tinplate producers must ship at once all finished tinplate which has been tied up in their plants by the strike. NPA reported that "a considerable amount" of the year's crops will be saved by the timely strike settlement and the efforts of the American Association of Railroads, can producers and steel companies.

Printers Win Pay Increase

CINCINNATI (AP)—A new wage agreement Monday gave 500 printers of Cincinnati's three daily newspapers a pay boost of \$3 a week. The AFL Typographical unionmen will receive \$103 for a 37 1/2 week as daytime workers and \$108 as night men. Papers affected are the Cincinnati Enquirer, Cincinnati Times-Star and Cincinnati Post. The wage agreement is retroactive to last Jan. 1 and will run through next May 31.
