Excitement In New Woolen Coats For Fall

This is a wonderful season to buy a new coat! Fabric manufacturers have produced a whole new world of woolen materials, and designers have fashioned them into a striking array of styles to fit almost any taste and figure.

These new woollens include brushed surfaces, such as, zibelines with their long-haired surface brushed flat and often combined with mohair to add luster; lots of

curly faces, like the poodle cloth introduced earlier, and various bouclets which range from densely nubbled surfaces to widely spaced loops; many tweeds so different you will scarcely recognize them; novelty worsted jerseys. Chin-chillas are new again, much like the ones you wore when you were a little girl. You will find fleeces that look new because of a longer, brushed surface.

The poodle weaves are clipped shorter this season and are less bulky than those first introduced, hence wearable by more women. The zibelines, as indeed to most of the coating woollens this season, lend the most luxurious air to a coat. The tweeds are dashing and colorful or muted and soft, sometimes using looped yarns to achieve new faces, important also in herringbone weaves. Jerseys are cooling weight and appear in various novelty patterns such as checks, stripes, herringbones, as well as the more familiar heather mixtures.

There is a new feeling in styling for fall, too, not a drastic change, but enough to make you want a

new coat. You will find coats ample but not so bulky, with some quite straight styles such as Chesterfields again in your favorite store. There is news in the tulle or morning glory silhouette, both with exaggerated and modified flare toward the hem from a semi-fitted waistline. More fitted coats are to be seen, with an easy rather than snug fit at the waist preferred. Some coats have voluminous caps all; some convert to a tuxedo front or may be worn wrapped over; some have an indication of the middy line in dot seaming or a set-on fold low on the hips.

There is a strong trend toward coats and suits matching in color and companionate in fabrics. Coat and dress fabrics are also paired in texture and dyes so that they

go together perfectly. The coatings are heavier and more noticeably textured than the suit or dress fabrics but always soft and comfortable to wear. Often the coat is midhip or slightly longer in these costumes, although the full length coat and the waist length jacket are well represented for your choice.

Recipe

Cook macaroni in boiling salted water until tender. Drain, and rinse thoroughly with cold water. Cut olives from pits into large pieces. Drain oil from tuna, and flake coarsely. Dice eggs. Combine macaroni, olives, tuna, eggs and cabbage. Blend mayonnaise, mustard, vinegar and salt, and toss lightly with salad mixture. Serves 4 to 6 generously.
