### Dessert On The Terrace

Top off an outdoor summer meal with a light and refreshing dessert of fresh oranges. Everything about a dessert of this type is easy... it's easy to prepare, easy to serve, and easy to eat. It's a family style dessert that can be dressed up for guests with the addition of several sprigs of parsley or fresh mint.

By serving fresh oranges for dessert, you'll be contributing valuable minerals and vitamins to the daily diet. For years, oranges have been known as one of the richest sources of vitamin C—the vitamin that cannot be stored in the body. As this vitamin has to be replenished daily to assure you of youthful energy, sound teeth and sound bones, oranges are important for good health. Recently, nutritionists announced that fresh oranges are an excellent source of proteopectin. These proteopectins aid in digestion and help you absorb a greater share of essential food elements from all foods you eat. These remarkable substances are found in the meaty solids of oranges. Therefore, it is more important than ever to eat whole oranges.

Most people prefer to pick up an orange and eat it in the hand. You can encourage them to eat this way by slicing each orange into eight sections. To do this quickly, start at the top of the orange, slice into half, leaving enough un-

cut skin at the bottom to hold the fruit together. Cut into half again, forming quarters, and then slice each of these into eighths. If desired, pull each orange open slightly to resemble flower petals, and top with parsley or mint. Arrange these orange "flowers" on a serving dish and let each person help himself while he lounges on the terrace.

Many homemakers like to keep this cooling drink in the refrigerator. It's a jiffy drink that can be whipped up for the kids when they come in for something cool to drink.

**FROZEN ORANGE PUNCH**  
 2/3 cup sugar  
 1/2 teaspoon salt  
 2 cups water  
 1 6 ounce can frozen concentrated orange juice (undiluted)



Boil sugar, salt, and two cups water for five minutes. Cool to room temperature. Add orange juice, lemon juice and four cups water. Stir until lemon juice is completely melted. Freeze in refrigerator tray at coldest point until firm, stirring occasionally. Makes 10 cups. To serve, spoon into tall glasses, garnish with orange slices.

## ON THE HOUSE

Thunder showers are forecast around this time of the year, so it's a good time to look over your roof before an old-fashioned cloudburst tests it and finds it lacking.

There's a common tendency to take a roof for granted, like father's pay day. But scarcely any part of a house takes the beating that a roof gets. Winter freezing and spring winds contrive more tawny twists than any bureau of standards can think up.

However, rarely is it worth while

to patch up the roof unless specific damage has been done to a particular spot—such as shingles being loosened by a falling tree limb. Usually roofing materials wear more or less uniformly and the first leak is a sign that the roof is wearing out all over.

Reliable roofers will tell you that the only practical way to repair a roof is to replace it. And the cheapest and best way to re-roof is to lay the new shingle over the old. This saves the expense of ripping off the old roofing, gives you a stronger, more rigid roof, and adds definite insulating value.

The increasing use of color in homes also gave asphalt shingles a boost. Made of asphalt impregnated felt, these shingles had to be given a coating of fire-resistant grit in their manufacture to meet tests against chimney sparks and flying brands. The mineral granules used for the coating were produced in a certain number of natural colors. So it was no longer necessary to have a roof of weather gray, if you didn't want it. You could have red, or blue, or black, or white.

With California ranch houses setting the color pace around the
