Lemonade Solves Guest Entertainin

When taking a lunch in the park you can solve the beverage problem by including Picnic Lemonade. This is lemonade that you mix at home, then finish when you arrive at the eating spot. It saves you time at the picnic as well as space in the picnic basket.

Here's all you do . . . before leaving home, squeeze two cups of fresh lemon juice, add four teaspoons of grated lemon peel, and one and one-half cups sugar. Stir this mixture until sugar is dissolved and pour into glass jar. A fruit jar or refrigerator container with tight top will do. Toss in a few thin lemon slices for decorative effect. When you arrive at the picnic ground, pour one-fourth cup of lemon syrup into each glass and fill with cold water. If you prefer a very cold drink, take ice cubes along and use one or two in each glass.

In addition to packing Picnic Lemonade for a lunch in the park, many homemakers like to keep it on hand in the refrigerator. It's a jiffy drink that can be whipped up for the kids when they come in for something cool to drink. It's not only cooling but replenishes much-needed pep and vitality for hot summer days.

Make up a batch of the cupcakes often because they have a wonderful spicy orange flavor that everyone will love. They keep well so you can make them ahead of time. The frosting is a plain butter and powdered sugar combination with orange juice used to make it thin enough to spread. Half-slices of orange that have been cut down the center and given a slight twist, decorate the top and make the cakes more dressy.

ORANGE SPICE CAKES
 1 1/3 cups sifted cake flour
 2 teaspoons baking powder
 1/4 teaspoon salt
 1 teaspoon cinnamon
 1 teaspoon allspice
 1/4 cup shortening
 2 teaspoons grated orange peel
 2 1/2 cup sugar
 1 egg
 1/4 cup evaporated milk
 1/4 cup fresh orange juice.

Sift flour with baking powder, salt, and spices. Cream shortening with orange peel, adding sugar gradually and creaming until light and fluffy. Add egg and beat until well blended. Combine milk and orange juice. Add flour mixture alternately with liquid, beginning and ending with flour. Put paper muffin cups into muffin pans and fill each cup two-thirds full. Makes 13 or 14 medium cup cakes. Bake in moderate oven (375) for about 20 minutes or until golden brown.

Waves Mark 10th Year

The WAVES of the United States Navy are ten years old. On July 30, 1942, the late President Franklin D. Roosevelt signed documents authorizing the commissioning and enlistment of women in the U.S. Naval Reserve. With the passage by the Congress of the Women's Armed Services Integration Act in June 1948, women became an integral part of the Regular Navy on a permanent basis.

Today 9,000 women on active duty celebrate the anniversary, serving in 28 of the Navy's 62 ratings, at Naval activities in the continental United States, Japan, Hawaii, Norway, Germany, France, Alaska and England.

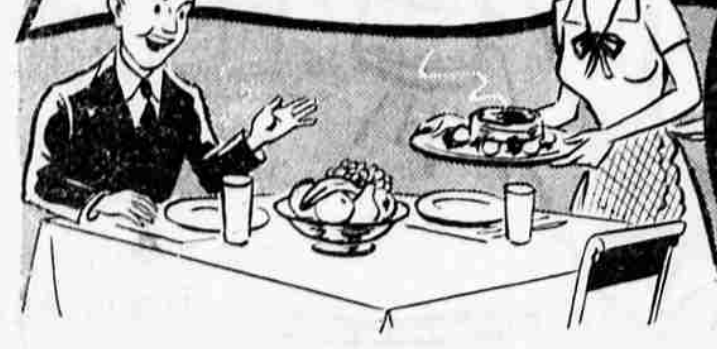
Two hundred and twenty in active service are on duty in the Thirteenth Naval District, and 500 more are members of Organized and Volunteer Reserve units in the states of Washington, Oregon, Idaho and Montana. Their duty is limited only by restrictions on serving in aircraft on combat missions, on ships other than hospital ships and transports, and in billets classified as "heavy duty".

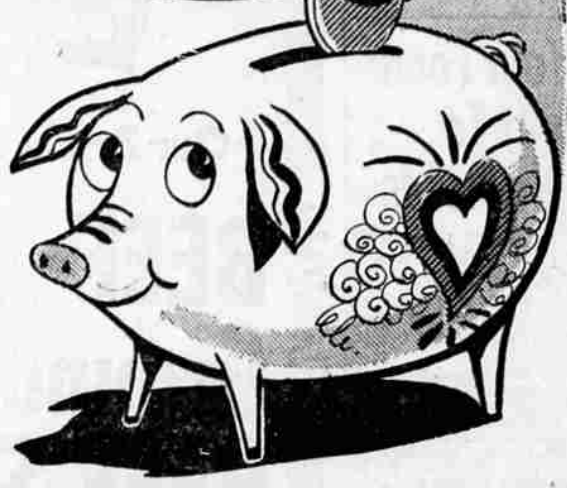
