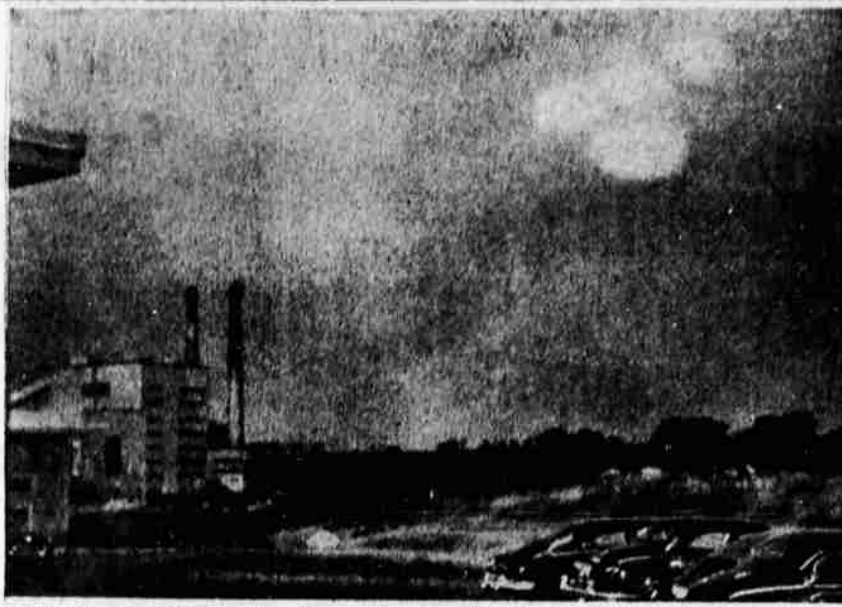

Scouts Slate Crater Hike

Modoc Area Council Explorer Scouts have set Aug. 16 as a tentative date for a two-day hike to Crater Lake, and Explorers wishing to participate are asked to contact the local Scout office at once.

The two groups are to start from Lake of the Woods and Crescent Lake, working their ways along the Skyline Trail to get to Crater Lake National Park over a period of a week.

The trip is to be closed off with an Eagle Scout Court of Honor. Present plans call for those Scouts starting at the Lake of the Woods to be guests of the U.S. Forest Service, and start the trip off in good fashion by climbing Mt. Pitt. The two Explorer groups expect to finish the mountain-top lakes en route, and may consider some field problems involving compass work.

The final day—a week after the start—is to be spent with excursions at Crater Lake, including a trip to Wizard Island and a climb to its top.
