### Big Year Seen For Pelicans

Pelican Football Coach Bob Hendershott isn't in the market for crying towels.

He has no need for them. Last season the Klamath Union High School gridders were dealt their lumps in one of the most disastrous seasons in the school's history.

They finished with an unflattering record of 2-8-1. That means two wins on an eight-game schedule, five losses and one tie.

On paper at least, it shouldn't be a tough chore for the Big Red and White pigskin machine to improve on that mark considerably.

Hendershott and new assistant Paul McCall will have the welcome mat out for nine lettermen—five backs and four linemen—come school-opening time.

The backs include Kenny Young who shows promise of being one of the state's best running backs. He was the only Pelican last year who could gain with any consistency for Klamath Falls in ball-toting assignments.

Other backfield returnees are George Maskell, Dick Lundsten, Cal Gilmore and George Hanson.

The linemen are Doug Campbell, Matthew Del Fatti, Jack Horton and Vernon Pryor.

Hendershott said recently he may return to the straight "I" formation—without variations—and a balanced line.

The addition of McCall to the coaching staff is expected to help McCall, well schooled in backfield duties, will probably major in that department.

McCall, better known for steering the Pelicans to two straight state basketball tournaments, takes the place of Dutch French, who quit coaching to devote full time to his multiple duties as the school's dean.
