Heirs Sought In Oregon

CHICAGO, Ill. —What happened to Heinrich (or Henri) Baumert? It's a \$13,000 question and Walter C. Cox, probate genealogist, 208 South LaSalle Street, Chicago, is searching the state of Oregon for the answer. Years ago Baumert left \$13,000

in the custody of others who have not heard from him since. They say he would be about 80 years old in the event he is still living. If he is not, then his heirs would be entitled to claim the money if they can be located.

"The little that is known about Baumert," Cox said, "indicates that he was of German origin, probably born in Alsace-Lorraine."

"Search for him is being centered in Oregon because he is known to have lived and worked at an unidentified locality in the state for many years."

"Should he be dead, his children or grandchildren, if any, would have first claim to the money, with brothers and sisters or nieces or nephews next in line."

Pendleton Man Dies In Home

PENDLETON (AP) — A Pendleton business man died trapped in the bedroom of his burning home here early Wednesday.

The body of Jerome Steiner, 41, co-owner of the Parker Taxi Co., apparently the only occupant of the house, was found by firemen. Coroner J. A. Folsom said Steiner died of asphyxiation. Unidentified motorists broke a window in the burning building and said they heard screams. They were unable to enter. Fire Chief William Bachelor said:

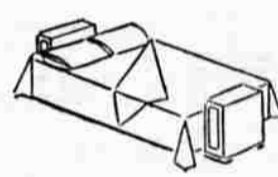
