National Health Group Sees Need For Doctors, Dentists

WASHINGTON (AP) — The President's commission on health needs of the nation was told Tuesday that thousands more dentists, nurses and medical assistants are needed to care for the American people.

Summaries of panel discussions held during the last two months by 21 medical, military and lay experts were presented at the opening of a two-day session by the commission.

The panel summaries indicated the exact shortage of trained people, including physicians and surgeons, depends upon how U. S. medical care is "organized."

Proposing a plan for doing this is one purpose of the commission. President Truman appointed its members last December. He has been planning for a national compulsory health insurance plan. The commission was told to study the facts and present a program for "safeguarding and improving the health of the nation."

The American Medical Association, opposed to what it calls "socialized medicine," has de-

Term Ends For Hallinan

TACOMA (AP) — McNeil Union Federal Prison doors will swing open Sunday for Vincent Hallinan, San Francisco attorney and Progressive Party candidate for President of the United States.

Hallinan, sentenced to six months for contempt of court in the Harry Bridges perjury trial, will leave the prison after serving about four months of the full sentence.

Credits for good behavior and for assignment to the prison honor camp reduced the time Hallinan must serve, Warden F. T. Wilkinson said Monday.

Hallinan, defense attorney at the West Coast longshoremen's union leader's perjury trial, entered the prison April 10.

Wilkinson said Hallinan worked on the prison farm most of the time and "made a very good adjustment."

Seattle leaders of the Washington State Progressive Party said they will welcome Hallinan when the prison boat docks here Sunday.

Japs Report Money Loss
TOKYO (AP)—A Japanese Parliament committee said Tuesday it has confirmed that a large quantity of Japanese national treasure is missing and that receipts by occupation officials for some of it are "extremely unclear and figures do not jibe."

The report said also that much of the treasure may have disappeared during World War II while the property was still in Japanese hands.

"We have confirmed the loss of a considerably large quantity of precious metals and diamonds, including the Empress Nagako's crown made of gold and platinum and studded with large diamonds," the committee said.

The Empress gave the crown to the government during the war as a patriotic example.

The exact amount of treasure unaccounted for was not reported by the committee. Japanese press estimates of total losses went as high as \$10 billion but were admittedly guesses.
