Duck Flight "Excellent"

NEW YORK (AP) — There was good news today for North American duck hunters. Arthur M. Bartley of New York, executive director of Ducks Unlimited, said today, "never have conditions on the prairies looked as good as they do this year, nor have I seen so many ducks with large broods." Bartley has just returned from a six weeks inspection tour of many of the organization's 300 waterfowl restoration areas in Western Canada. Ducks Unlimited is an international organization dedicated to waterfowl conservation. "Conditions this year are the result of two consecutive seasons when rainfall on the prairies has been adequate and a relatively large breeding stock returned to nest and breed," Bartley said. "There is nothing I can see that will effect the largest fall migration out of Canada in Ducks Unlimited's history."

Scouts Visit Lake Camp

This year's attendance at Crescent Lake's Camp Makualla — the Modoc Area Council's Boy Scout camp site — drew the largest number of boys in the history of the camp. Scout Executive Harold Shearer announced today. The camp ran from June 29 to Aug. 2, and attracted 666 boys from throughout the area. Last year the number was somewhat over the 400 mark, Shearer said. Makualla covers 35 acres on the Crescent Lake shoreline, and includes a dining hall and trading post among its buildings. There are seven troop sites in the area. Addition of a new course in field sports attracted interest this season, Shearer said. That included archery, riflery and angling, the latter including bait and fly casting and fly-tying. Waterfront activities are one of the more popular sports at the camp, and Shearer said the popularity was retained again this year.
