long-range smart as anybody. Specifically, the word is that they are thinking seriously of sending only Bob Perry, 19, and Tony Trabert, 22, to Australia next winter to challenge for the big cup. It sounds fantastic, but we've talked with a couple of rather knowing tennis gents here, and each said that, strictly of the record, he wouldn't be greatly surprised if this plan were adopted.
