BATON ROUGE, La. (AP)—Louisiana Democratic leaders pledged to Gov. Adlai Stevenson the party's 10 electors and rooster emblem but withheld endorsement.

The 100-member Democratic State Central Committee whipped up a 77-9 vote yesterday to assure the Stevenson-Sparkman ticket full billing on the ballot.

It was a victory for Stevenson and Sen. John Sparkman of Alabama, the national party nominees, although members said they were not necessarily endorsing them and certainly were not endorsing the party platform.

## Forest Fire Claims Life

BEATON, B. C. (AP)—A second forest fire turned man-killer in British Columbia Wednesday, taking the life of a 40-year-old logging operator.

Deaf is John Ribalkin, struck by a flaming fire while fighting a 100-acre fire 23 miles from this southeastern B. C. village.

Previously the Burns Lake fire in B. C.'s north-central interior took two lives. The body of one firefighter was found a week ago and another man is missing and presumed dead.
