

Mrs. Cornett Feted Before Convention

Women played an important part in the Republican National Convention at Chicago and are expected to take an even more important role in the election of the next president, according to Mrs. Olive Cornett, National Committee woman from Oregon, recently returned from the Midwest.

One hundred, twenty eight women delegates and 252 women alternates were seated, an all-time high for a national convention. Other hundreds participated as spectators.

There are 49 1/2 million women of voting age in the U. S. and nine million young people who have become eligible to cast a ballot since

Mrs. Cornett had numerous friends in the Taft camp, who after the nomination of General Eisenhower all agreed that the Republican party must work together for a Republican victory.
