State Board Slates Meet

SALEM (AP) — The Oregon State Emergency Board, a legislative committee which advises the governor on how he should spend his \$1,000,000 emergency fund, will meet here Friday.

The board will consider requests by Secretary of State Earl T. Newberry for \$40,000 to make up a deficit in printing the state Voters Pamphlet, and a request for \$19,000 to make up a salary deficit at the State Training School for Boys at Woodburn.

James Lamb, superintendent of the training school, told the Board of Control Tuesday that the \$19,000 is needed to pay salaries. The institution is jammed to capacity, and is growing much faster than the last legislature expected.

Lamb said he has 553 boys under his care, including 175 at the institution. The rest are placed in private homes and in the school's work camp.

Lamb said 53 boys were admitted to school in July and August, compared with 28 in the similar period of last year.

He reported to the board that the cost of taking care of each boy averages \$1,050 a year.

The board of control members discussed the proposed construction of a women's building to be located outside the walls of the state penitentiary. The women now are in cramped quarters on the second floor of the prison administration building.

The project is No. 7 on the board's list of proposed institution buildings, but the board said it might have to give it a higher priority.

MOSLEM SCHOOLS

KUALA LUMPUR (AP) — Arabic schools in the northern Malay states are responsible for turning out Malaya's future Moslem religious leaders. Resembling the monasteries of England in the Middle Ages, the Arabic institutions are maintained by Malays out of a religious fund. Students pay no school fees. Students spend eight years in these institutions and go to Cairo or Mecca for higher religious studies.
