New Clothes Dryer Cuts Laundry Time-Labor

Popularity of automatic clothes dryers is growing with such enthusiasm that conservative estimates by industry spokesmen indicate there will be 1,000,000 of these home aids in use by the end of 1952 and 10,000,000 by 1962.

Saving of time and labor and the happy advantage of being able to dry clothes any time without regard to weather are factors in the acceptance of the automatic clothes dryer. Clothes are dried in clean, heated air where no soot can touch them.

Disadvantages of some early model dryers have been eliminated in the 1952 model dryer added to the home appliances manufactured by a leading firm. Excess room moisture, lint from tumbling fabrics and heat in the laundry room have been controlled in this dryer without expensive outdoor venting.

Built in the dryer, which matches the manufacturer's washer in design, is a new filtrator-condenser. This device removes both moisture and lint. Fresh room air flows over the condenser continually, keeping it cool, as the lint-laden warm moist air from the dryer passes through the filtrator tubes. Lint is trapped as the moisture condenses.

This moisture then drains into a tray below. If desired a flexible drain tube may be attached to provide connection to carry collected water to a floor drain. Lint removal from the filtrator is done monthly, often if needed.

when chenille spreads or fluffy cotton rugs are dried. Emptying of the moisture tray will vary with the efficiency of the washer used with it. When used with the same manufacturer's washer, emptying the pan once a week is recommended in normal use.

Timing and heat controls are located on the back panel. Up to 65 minutes of drying time may be allowed. The machine may be stopped to add or remove clothes without changing the setting. A variable heat control is marked for medium, high and low settings as well as fabric classification to eliminate guess work for the proper temperature setting a particular material demands.

Door and loading port into the tumbling drum are located high enough to permit a clothes basket to be placed directly below. The door swings back flush with cabinet sides allowing loading from either side. Porcelain enamel finish inside and out prevents rusting or corrosion.

Heating tubes are sealed in to obtain maximum results and avoid any exposed electrical connections. An ozone lamp in the drying compartment stays on while the dryer is operating to give clothes a fresh, outdoor air smell.

Recipe

JIFFY DESSERT

12 vanilla wafers
1 pkg. instant chocolate pudding
2 cups chilled milk

Line bottom and sides of a one-quart casserole with 12 vanilla wafers. Pour milk into a deep one-quart mixing bowl and empty contents of one package instant chocolate pudding on top of milk. Beat with rotary egg beater (or electric mixer at slow to medium speed) until smooth, about one minute. Pour into cookie-lined casserole and top with four vanilla wafers. Chill in refrigerator until firm, about 20 minutes. Garnish with whipped cream, if desired. Serves 5-6.
