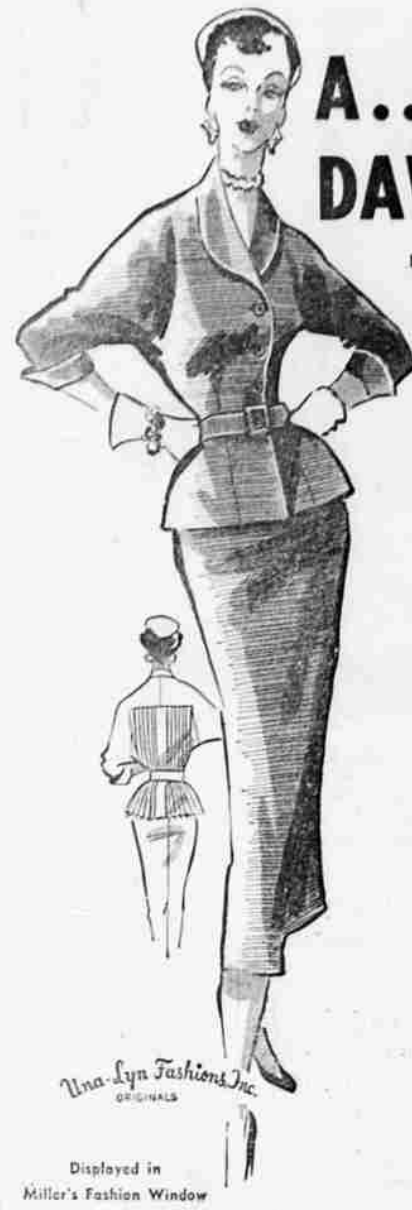
## Pre-School Party

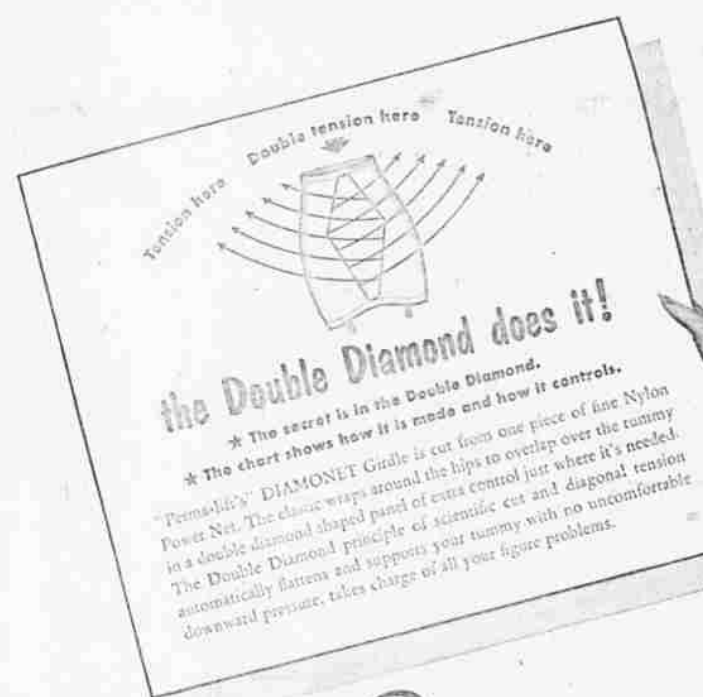
