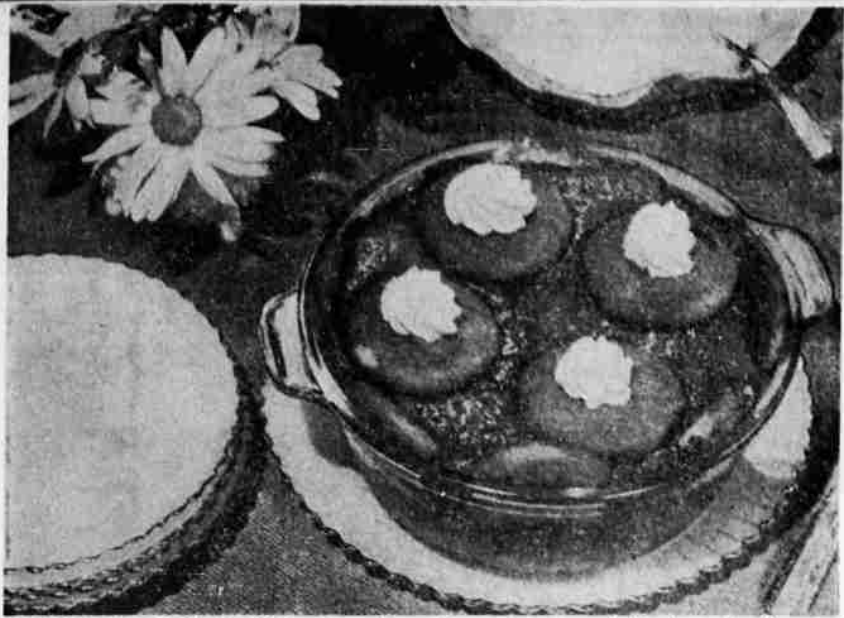

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HARVEST APPLE CAKE

- 1½ cups thinly sliced pared apples
- ¾ cup molasses
- 1-3 cup shortening
- 1-3 cup hot water
- 2½ cups sifted enriched flour
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon cloves
- 1 teaspoon mace or nutmeg
- 1½ teaspoons baking soda
- 1½ teaspoon salt

Combine apples and molasses; slowly cook until apples are tender drain off molasses and combine with shortening and water. Heat until shortening melts. Cool. Sift together flour, sugar, cinnamon, cloves, mace, baking soda and salt. Add molasses mixture; mix well. Add apples. Line 8" x 2" greased pan with greased waxed paper; pour in batter. Bake at 350 F. (Moderate oven) 45 minutes. Serve warm with plain or whipped cream or ice cream. Makes 8 to 12 servings.

MOLASSES RAISIN BREAD

- 1 cup molasses
- 1 egg
- 1 cup milk
- 2 cups whole wheat flour
- 1½ teaspoon baking soda
- 1½ teaspoon salt
- 1½ teaspoon baking powder
- 1½ cups bran

Recipe

2 tablespoons shortening
½ cup raisins.
Mix the molasses, beaten egg and milk. Mix flour with soda, baking powder and salt. Mix with the bran, and add these dry ingredients to the molasses mixture. Then add the melted shortening and raisins, and mix well. Bake in a oven (350 F.) for forty-five minutes.

MOLASSES BREAD PUDDING

- 10 slices stale bread, diced
- 2 eggs
- 3 tablespoons molasses
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- 2 cups milk, scalded
- 2 tablespoons butter, melted.

Arrange bread cubes in well-greased baking dish. Beat eggs, molasses, sugar and salt together. Add milk and butter. Pour over bread cubes. Place in baking dish in pan of hot water and bake at 350 F. (moderate oven) 1 hour or until firm. Makes 6 servings.

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
