Rangoon Said Communist Hot Spot

RANGOON (AP)—This "neutral" capital of Burma is the hottest spot of Communist propaganda in Southeast Asia.

Two out of every three bookstalls splash expensively printed magazines extolling the glories of Stalin and Mao Tse-tung. Queues line up at the downtown King Theater, leased by the Soviet Embassy, to see Russian-made motion pictures. The Communist "peace dove" decorate the Rangoon University magazine, published by students who recently elected a Red-dominated "Progressive party" slate in university elections.

You can buy—and lots of Burmese are doing so—the special issue of "China Pictorial" featuring irrefutable evidence concerning the use of bacteriological warfare by the American aggressors.

The United States so far has allocated \$1 million dollars for economic aid to Burma in the form of machinery, materials and services of technicians. The United States Information Service library is fairly well attended and U.S. technical training films are in demand.

Much of this has been effective, particularly in winning the appreciation of some government officials, but in the streets among the

masses, the Communists are far ahead of America in this propaganda battle.

Tons of literature, given away or sold for a few cents, pour into Burma from Red China and the Soviet Union. The propaganda campaign is directed by people who know their business.

The usual tracts on Marxism are outdone by dozens of slick paper magazines with color printing fully as good as America's best. The Soviet-leased theater, which operates like an ordinary movie house, mixes its out-and-out propaganda films with some of Russia's best movies. The Communists have subsidized a Burmese motion picture company to make Red-splanted movies in the local language.

To meet this propaganda challenge in the same arena, a privately financed American organization, the Committee for Free Asia, has set up shop in Rangoon and other Asian areas. It is headed by Alan Valentine as president,

with headquarters in San Francisco.

One CFA project in Rangoon is a "Free World" bookstore selling anti-Communist books and magazines at or below cost. Its aim is to out-propagandize the Reds at their own game.

CFA is meeting the movie challenge by assisting in the production of anti-Communist Burmese films. It will aid independent student movements in the university fighting the well-organized Communists. Books will be translated into Burmese and printed on CFA presses.

Commission Awards Bids

PORTLAND (AP)—Contracts for two river bridges—one on the new Portland-Salem short route and the other over the Coguille River in Coos County—were awarded Tuesday by the State Highway Commission.

The awards went to the low bidders and included in both jobs were highway work as well.

The work on the Portland-Salem route was divided into two parts—one a bridge to replace the Wilsonville ferry over the Willamette River and the other for 2.11 miles of highway linking the bridge with the Wilsonville-Hubbard road.

The winning bidders were Bethlehem Pacific Coast Bridge Co., Seattle, at \$462,872 for the bridge, and Roy L. Houck and Son, Salem, at \$320,721 for the highway.

On the Coos County job a half mile of roadway and a movable span bridge at the Bullard's Ferry site was let under a single contract to Carl M. Halvorson, Portland, at \$629,993.

In other action the commission approved a plan to share with Astoria the cost of putting in a one-way traffic grid in that city.

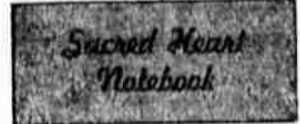

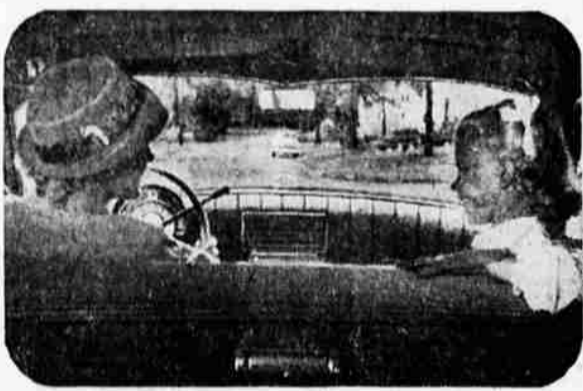
